When your child is online, 'Content, Contact, Conduct' is the easiest way to think of the risks they may face. It's exactly the same whether your child is gaming, making videos to upload onto YouTube or using apps such as TikTok.

CONTENT: What can my child see? Am I happy with this? Is it age-appropriate?

CONTACT: Can my child contact others? Can other people contact my child?

Can I set privacy settings? Can I block or report inappropriate comments?

CONDUCT: What is the behaviour of my child online? Does my child act differently because they are behind a screen?
